Volunteering

Peru



PROGRAM

This volunteer program takes place in Cusco, the historic capital of the Inka Empire, located in Peru's central south, near the sacred valley of the Andes mountain range.

The volunteer programs focus on sustainable solutions to poverty. As such this unique program offers exciting hands-on work opportunities, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.

Meaningful & Sustainable

All volunteers will work in partnership with local people in a variety of community-based projects. You will be placed based on your experiences, interests and availability in orphanages, schools, libraries, local branches of an international NGO, native plant rehabilitation, etc. A minimum of 2 weeks project work commences after a 2-week intensive language course in Cusco.

Live & Learn the Peruvian style

You will stay with a host family and no more than 10 minutes by bus to school. Participants choosing to stay with a family should recognise that a certain degree of flexibility will be required to adjust to the Peruvian customs and way of life. Our local families host up to two or three (max) students at a time and provide you with three meals per day and weekly laundry service.

Volunteers will attend a minimum of 2 weeks of language classes to ensure a smooth transition and adaptation to the Peruvian lifestyle and culture. The school is in a beautiful and historical colonial home from the 19th century with 17 classrooms, video room, indoor patio, auditorium, entertainment room and wireless Internet access.

It all starts with an idea!

If you have an idea and would like to propose an original project that will contribute to the core principals of the program, you are invited to submit a work plan (2 – 5 pages) to Volunteer Abroad.

Available Placements

Clinic: feed, bath and play with children, assist in teaching or help in the physical therapy department, in the greenhouse or in the administrative office

Kindergarten: self-starters required to work independently in these schools on the outskirts of Cusco

Elderly care: The joy that volunteers bring to the elderly is evidenced by their smiles when you walk in the door.

School: assist in the classroom and with a variety of occupational activities. Fundraising and project marketing assistance always required.

Local business: help promote this coca products business and reduce its association with the production of cocaine.

Volunteering

Ecuador



PROGRAM

Experience the capital of Ecuador, the second largest city in the country and the second highest capital in the world. Elevated to 2850m you will find yourself on the city's central square or the "Plaza de La Independencia".

All projects are located in Quito and rely on volunteers fighting poverty-induced issues in the community.

Make a difference – fight indifference!

The volunteer program is for people interested in learning about sustainable solutions to poverty. All volunteers will work in partnership with local people in a variety of community-based projects. This unique program offers exciting hands-on work opportunities, meaningful cultural immersion, and an enriching language program.

Live & Learn!

You will stay with a host family and in most cases no more than 10 minutes by bus to school. Participants choosing to stay with a family should recognise that a certain degree of flexibility will be required to adjust to Ecuadorian customs and way of life. Our local families provide you with a loving, attentive home network, three meals per day and weekly laundry service. Hotel accommodation can also be arranged if desired at an additional cost.

Volunteers must attend a minimum of 2 weeks of language classes to ensure a smooth transition and adaptation to the Ecuadorian lifestyle and culture. The school is situated in the centre of the capital city, Quito, and is well equipped with a library, a working area and wireless internet access.

Available Placements

After 2, 4 or 6 weeks of language classes and based on your interests and availability, you will then be placed in one of the following projects:

- Childcare centre for incarcerated women
- After school centre for underprivileged youth
- Help children with Down Syndrome; Centre for street children
- Girls' Orphanage; Indigenous School
- Women's Support Centre; School for farmers' children
- Live-in medical facility; Children or General hospital

In order to complete a successful program you must be able to show a lot of flexibility and humility.

Volunteering

Costa Rica



THE PROGRAM

Conveniently located in the middle of the country, San José, the capital of Costa Rica, offers volunteers a plethora of cultural activities, social events and a base camp to plan further travels and adventures from.

After completing your Spanish course (from one to four weeks), you will work as a volunteer in several communities and immediately apply your newly acquired language skills. Volunteers can choose between a social project in San José and ecological/conservation projects in National Parks.

Live & Learn!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is from the inside! Volunteers will live with a host family, who provide breakfast, dinner and laundry service.

During your first weeks in San José you will be placed in classes according to your Spanish proficiency level, which is determined by an evaluation exam before starting your course.

The school offers additional cultural activities such as

- Latin dance classes
- Costa Rican cooking classes
- Extra conversation practice hours

After completing the first 1 to 4 weeks of intensive Spanish classes (1 week for advanced and 4 weeks for beginners; 20hrs per week) in small groups, you will be placed in a social project outside San José.

Sample Placements

Our partner school will help you locate a volunteer project that suits you best. You will be able to help street children, give a hand in a school, a library etc.

As a general rule, volunteer placements in Costa Rica will be set up at the volunteer's arrival and require an intermediate level of Spanish.

Example projects

- Day care for poverty-stricken working parents of young children
- Day care centre in an international NGO
- School dedicated to autistic children

Volunteering

Guatemala



PROGRAM

Nestled in a beautiful green valley, about 45 km from Guatemala City, Antigua is the Spaniards old capital, founded in 1542. As volunteers will be in direct and regular contact with locals, it is imperative for you to learn Spanish upon your arrival. Prior to your placement in a project you will therefore receive private lessons in preparation for your interactions with the local people you will come in contact with in various humanitarian projects.

Live & Learn!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is from the inside! Volunteers will live with a host family and gain insight into the real way of life, by living, laughing and eating with the locals. Host families also provide breakfast, dinner and weekly laundry service for the duration of the language course. If the volunteer project is located further out of town, alternate accommodation will be arranged.

After your arrival in Antigua your language skills will be assessed and your private lessons arranged accordingly. This way it is ensured that you will receive highly intensive lessons and lessons that are relevant to your particular circumstances.

Sample Placements

Our partner school will assist us in organising a volunteer project that suits you best prior to your arrival. The main projects evolve around humanitarian projects and require motivation, dedication and your commitment to the tasks given.

Example projects/locations/positions

- Assistant in a day care centre for very poor children (age: 0-6) whose parents have alcohol problems or single
- Assistant teacher various institutions
- Assistant teacher, social worker or coordinator in various orphanages
- Red Cross – health care, rehabilitation, construction
- And much much more!

Remember: The purpose of volunteering is to give something to others without asking for anything in return except the satisfaction of having accomplished an important mission.

Volunteering

West Africa



PROGRAM

Some of our most challenging projects take place in the various programs in Benin, Burkina Faso, Senegal or Ghana. Since Ghana is an English speaking country and Benin, Burkina Faso and Senegal are French-speaking, we recommend volunteers to the latter three to participate in French language courses. It is important to remember that the success of the program is reliant on your motivation, determination, interaction as well as your communication with the local communities.

As a volunteer, you will work with an NGO or local associations in humanitarian projects that tackle the effects of poverty on the most vulnerable in our societies.

Live & Learn from the inside!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is from the inside! You can stay with a host family in all 4 destinations. Depending on the projects, volunteers may alternatively stay on site instead (eg: orphanage). During your spare time, you can travel within the country in which you are volunteering in or visit neighbouring countries.

Our partners in West Africa will endeavour to arrange free accommodation for participants through the local receiving organisation in the area you will work. You will, however, be required to pay the utilities such as water, electricity and telephone bills. Except for Burkina Faso where accommodation and meals are included in the program fee, an additional fee of 200 – 250 USD per month applies to cover all living expenses. The accommodation has basic furnishings. Please note there are no guarantees that free accommodation will be obtained and if not, the partner organisation advises participants on how to source their own accommodation.

About the projects

All work locations will be in or near the main regional towns and villages. The projects are in area such as education, agriculture, infrastructure development (sanitary, electricity...), environment, developing arts and crafts and micro enterprises, childcare (orphanages, social work), improving women's conditions, AIDS prevention programs, help disabled people, technical and administrative assistant to NGO.

You need to be flexible. Getting involved in a humanitarian project means that you are ready to help wherever it is required. Some projects require experience or specific qualifications.

South Africa



PROGRAM

The world in one country

South Africa is a land of extraordinary beauty, mystery and adventure, varying climatic conditions, vegetation, abundance of animals, diversity of cultures, languages and religions, but also marked by the extremes of first world development and third world difficulties.

Gain first hand knowledge of a new nation that has learnt to overcome discrimination and that has moved towards progress and development.

Live & Learn!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is from the inside! Experience the real South African lifestyle by living in the community, either with a host family or similar accommodation, such as a hostel or staff quarters on the project site. The host families/hosts provide food and lodging for the full period. Accommodation is normally a shared room with other volunteers and within walking distance to the volunteer site.

Work & Learn!

Volunteers are greeted with a seven-day orientation in Cape Town before starting the volunteer project. You will gain an understanding of the people, culture, languages and political climate of South Africa. It will also give you the necessary travel, safety and medical advice and prepare you for your upcoming projects.

During your orientation you will also:

- ☉ Go on a historical walk of Cape Town
- ☉ Visit Robben Island
- ☉ Visit nearby townships
- ☉ Go on wine excursion
- ☉ Go on a Peninsula day excursion

After the orientation week volunteers will be taken to their host families and start volunteering the following day.

Placement Opportunities

While most programs are suitable for applicants of 18 to 30 years of age, mature volunteers are welcome to apply. In all cases, acceptance will depend upon project availability, background knowledge, related studies and the applicant's motivation, experiences and other relevant skills.

Project Areas:

Social: Work in community development projects, with abandoned children and disabled people.

Health: Work in local community clinics and day hospitals. Knowledge in the medical field is required.

Tourism: Produce tourism brochures, business plans and organise fundraising events in the community

Educational: Assist in schools and work with children of all ages

Environmental: Contribute to the wildlife redevelopment of many forgotten gorgeous and nature reserves

India



PROGRAM

Experience the people, culture, religion and nature of South India. In our projects you will live and work with people from all around the world. Inspired, enriched and enchanted by the surrounding traditional, colourful and vibrant Indian culture, volunteering in these humanitarian or conservation projects promise an unforgettable and unique experience.

Live & Learn!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is by living it! Depending on the placement, volunteers may live in host families, on site or in one of the regional centres. In all cases, meals are provided. You will kick off your volunteering experience with a two-week orientation and culture session where you will learn about the Indian culture and customs, the language, practice yoga and explore Bangalore and its gorgeous sights. After that, you will be fully prepared to embark on your own volunteering adventure to experience the Indian way of life through your own eyes.

Pick & Pack!

Your placement into a project is organised individually and based on your preferences in your application. We request all participants to make a minimum of three choices in their application. While we always try to place you in your first preference, some projects may not be available at the time of your application. Alternatively you will be placed in your second or third choice. So pick from a range of exciting volunteer projects and get ready to pack your bags!

Projects

Together with our partner we will organise a volunteer project that suits you best prior to your arrival. The main projects evolve around humanitarian projects and require motivation, dedication and your continuous commitment:

- Schools:** develop lessons and plan ideas for children aged 5 to 15 or work with physically or mentally handicapped, blind children and orphans
- Ecological work:** turtle conservation, tree planting, social-forestry, water shed management...
- Retirement Homes:** help with daily activities, medical care, special programs for physical exercise...
Health/Medical: Alcohol and drug rehabilitation program; variety of HIV/AIDS projects
- Construction:** lend a hand in various community projects

Volunteering

Thailand



PROGRAM

Explore the central province of Singburi and its beautiful nature, sights and traditional festivals while working with children of all ages in schools or orphanages. Located in central Asia, Thailand is a traveller's paradise and haven for exploring majestic jungles and turquoise coastlines.

Get your hands on work that matters!

Volunteers have a choice to either teach a language in schools or work in orphanages. The program starts fortnightly and kicks off with a two-week welcome and orientation session, where you will learn everything you need to know about Thai culture, customs and your project. During the second half of the orientation, volunteers will stay in a typical village in the North of Thailand and discover the lifestyle and culture of the Akhas. The Akhas belongs to a different ethnic group than the Thais and live essentially from agriculture and forestry.

Projects:

Language teacher in primary or high school

The kind of schedule and the focus of the project will be adapted to the season, the possibilities and the needs of the moment, to improve students' long-term future prospects. Working hours: Monday to Friday, four to five hours per day.

Orphanage:

Assist in the education and daily life for children of all ages. This includes organising games, gardening, teaching them respect for the environment, exploring cultures and learning about the world. Working hours: Monday to Friday, up to 8 hours per day.

Your placement into a project is organised individually and based on your preferences in your application. While we always try to place you in your first preference, some projects may not be available at the time of your application.

Live & Learn

Volunteers live in basic conditions and in shared rooms with other volunteers from all around the world. While meals are included, volunteers share all chores of preparing meals, cooking, washing dishes, ... in a relaxed atmosphere.

Do you want to go solo?

The individual volunteering program offers participants the unique experience to live and work together with the locals for a designed period. Placement in the program is individually but usually there are several participants joining each month.

PROGRAM

Serenity – Inspiration - Unity

Our conservation partner in the US operates under the philosophy that physically demanding work in inspiring locations such as the Grand Canyon, the red rocks of Sedona, and the soaring mountains throughout Arizona has the power to unite people in a common cause.

Volunteers come from many nations around the world to work in small teams on direct service projects for the National Forest Service, National Park Service and other land management agencies throughout Arizona, southern Nevada, and southern Utah.

Test your boundaries!

Volunteers are expected to provide 40 hours per week of effort and enthusiasm (generally four days of work, three days of rest) in return for the opportunity to participate with like-minded young adults in a geographically and culturally inspiring setting.

The projects you will work on include taking care of and maintaining the area (for example planting trees), doing rockwork, ecological restoration, and installing railways. It is hard physical work but the wonderful scenery certainly makes up for it. During your work period the following is provided: transportation to and from project sites, tents for use on projects and food that will be cooked as a group.

During your time off, you will share an apartment with 16 other persons. The project starts every three to four weeks depending of the season.

ACCOMMODATION

During the projects, participants will stay in tents or in other types of basic accommodation (eg: no shower, no warm water) depending of the site. During your days off, volunteers stay in Flagstaff, a lively city of 60.000 inhabitants and sunshine 300 days a year. Accommodation will be in dorms with shared bathrooms. During days off, meals need to be paid by the volunteer.

PROGRAM TIMES

The program is available all year around for eight to 12 weeks except mid-December to January. The transfer between Phoenix airport and Flagstaff may be included, depending of your arrival date. Contact us for the start date of the program.

CONSERVATION

Costa Rica



THE PROGRAM

Conveniently located in the middle of the country, San José, the capital of Costa Rica, offers volunteers a plethora of cultural activities, social events and a base camp to plan further travels and adventures from.

After completing your Spanish course (from one to four weeks), you will be placed in an ecological/conservation project in a National Park nearby San José .

Week 1 – 4: Live & Learn!

The best way to experience a country, its customs and its culture is from the inside! Volunteers will live with a host family, who provide breakfast, dinner and laundry service for the entire duration of the language course.

During your first weeks in San José you will be placed in classes according to your Spanish proficiency level, which is determined by an evaluation exam before starting your course.

The school offers additional cultural activities such as

- Latin dance classes
- Costa Rican cooking classes
- Extra conversation practice hours

After completing the first 1 to 4 weeks of intensive Spanish classes (1 week for advanced and 4 weeks for beginners; 20hrs per week) in small groups (max 5p/group), you will be placed in your conservation project outside San José.

From week 5 onwards: Your Volunteer Project

Our partner school will help you locate a volunteer project that suits you best. As a general rule, volunteer placements in Costa Rica will be set up at the volunteer's arrival and require an intermediate level of Spanish.

Volunteer work includes building, cleaning, maintenance of paths in the jungle, making tourist material and posters, guarding parks, giving tourist information in English, giving environmental information to children, doing construction and maintenance of park installations. Working hours: 5-6 days per week

During the eco project, you will be accommodated in or around the national park together with other volunteers or Costa Rican park officials.

Live and work in the historical city of Yantai in Shandong Province. Yantai is one of the major Chinese coastal cities and tourist attractions, historical heritage and relics, boasting of a total population of over 6.4 million.



Your life in China

All volunteers will stay in apartments on campus. Each individual volunteer has his or her own fully furnished, private room, including TV, phone, air-conditioner or fan and bathroom. Some rooms may also have computers with free Internet access.

Placements

Volunteer teachers come to a Chinese school as an assistant classroom teacher. Volunteers will mainly teach conversational English in class by choosing their own topics. There will be one Chinese teacher sent to each class to help the volunteer teachers.

The average class size is about 50 students per class, while many schools have bigger classes with over 60 or even 70 students in each class. In addition to teaching English language, you may also choose to teach science, arts, sports, music in class or outdoors. Volunteers teach from Monday to Friday, and most classes take place in the morning, while a few classes may take place in the afternoon. The teaching loads vary from school to school but usually volunteers teach two to four hours per day.

Explore Shandong

Volunteers may also choose to do local hiking and excursions during their free time, and there are many local scenic and relics to visit such as Penglai Pavilion, Nanshan Grand Buddha, and Mou's Manor, Kunyu Daoist Mountains and Horsing Raising Island and Tashan Park, Yantai Hill Park and Changyu Winery Museum.

THE SCHOOLS/CLASSES

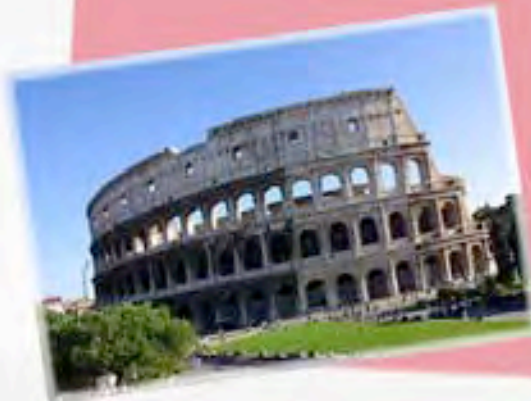

THE SCHOOLS/CLASSES

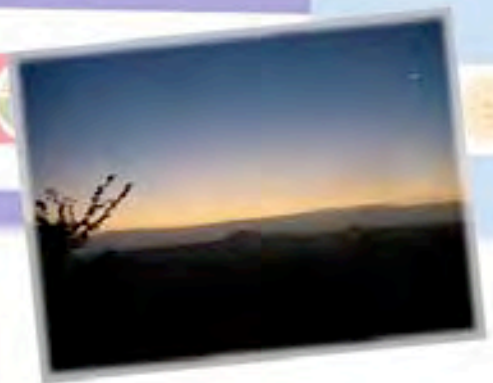

Latin America



THE SCHOOLS/CLASSES

Why not choose an exotic destination to learn Spanish? Our partner in Latin America offers quality Spanish courses in a number of countries. The extensive learning program contains 20 courses per week (one course = 55 minutes) and this leaves you enough time to discover the region where you are studying. The program covers grammar, oral comprehension, vocabulary, and oral expression. Schools offer at least six different levels from beginner to advance and you will be placed in a level that suits you best. It is important to note that school infrastructures in Latin America are less developed than in our country.

Costa Rica (San Jose) Costa Rica, "the rich coast" has borders with Nicaragua and Panama and it has approximately four million inhabitants. The "Ticos" (nickname given to locals), are renowned for their hospitality, their love of freedom and peace. Costa Rica has been a democracy for over 100 years and its army has been abolished since 1948. Located in San Jose, the capital, the school has 29 classrooms, a dance room (if you wish to practise Latin dance) an Internet access, a large garden, a kitchen (if you wish to follow local cuisine classes).

Ecuador (Quito): With its two million inhabitants, the capital of Ecuador offers a high standard of living. The 13-year-old school is registered with the Ecuadorian education department. On top of the school facilities, the students can enjoy the school pool, a sauna and a Turkish bath. There is also a soccer field, a big garden and a games room.

Guatemala (Antigua): Guatemala's population is +/- 8 million and its capital is Guatemala City. Spanish classes are given at Antigua, a small city (former capital of the country) that has preserved its authentic charm. The school was founded in 1992 and occupies a typical period house. The infrastructures are simple but the advantage of our partner school in Antigua is to propose private courses (1to1) at a very affordable rate.

Peru (Cusco) Peru is located below the equator along the Pacific coast and has 28 million inhabitants. The country has borders with Colombia, Brazil, Bolivia and Chile. The Inca civilisation was predominant until the 1500, after which the country was conquered by the Spanish. It became independent only in 1821. 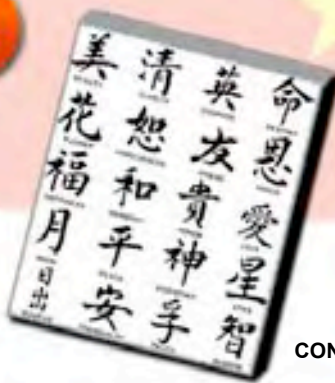

China



THE SCHOOL/CLASSES

You will study in the international exchange school on the Yantai University Campus. The semester programs start twice a year (around end February/start of March and end-August/start-September)

Classes are from Monday to Friday. Generally, you will receive four hours a day of Chinese (one class = 45 minutes) from 8.30AM to 12PM.

- ④ Application: Complete the application form and return it to WEP Australia together with a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00. Cheque or money transfer to our bank account is suitable as long as any transfer has full details accompanying it. The deposit will be deducted from the total program fee. After receipt of the application and deposit, we will send you a written confirmation together with the necessary documents in order to organise your program.
- ④ Application deadlines: Refer to the program conditions. The deadlines mentioned are necessary to organise your program. For certain programs a visa is required. You should therefore apply as soon as possible in order to leave enough time to apply for a visa. A valid passport is required for all programs and the passport must have six months validity on your return to Australia. Applying for a passport can take several weeks, so it is important to apply as soon as possible.
- ④ Program Price: Unless otherwise mentioned, price does not include mandatory medical insurance, return transport, pocket money, (covering leisure, transport, school supplies, excursions...) transfer from the airport to place of stay, passport and visa fees. Prices are accurate throughout the entire year in which the participant applies. If accommodation is included, it is mentioned in the program description. If during your stay the language school closes for a public holiday, accommodation will not be included. If the participant applies for a program for the following year, prices are subject to changes depending on our international partners.
